Introduction to Trigon and our Partners

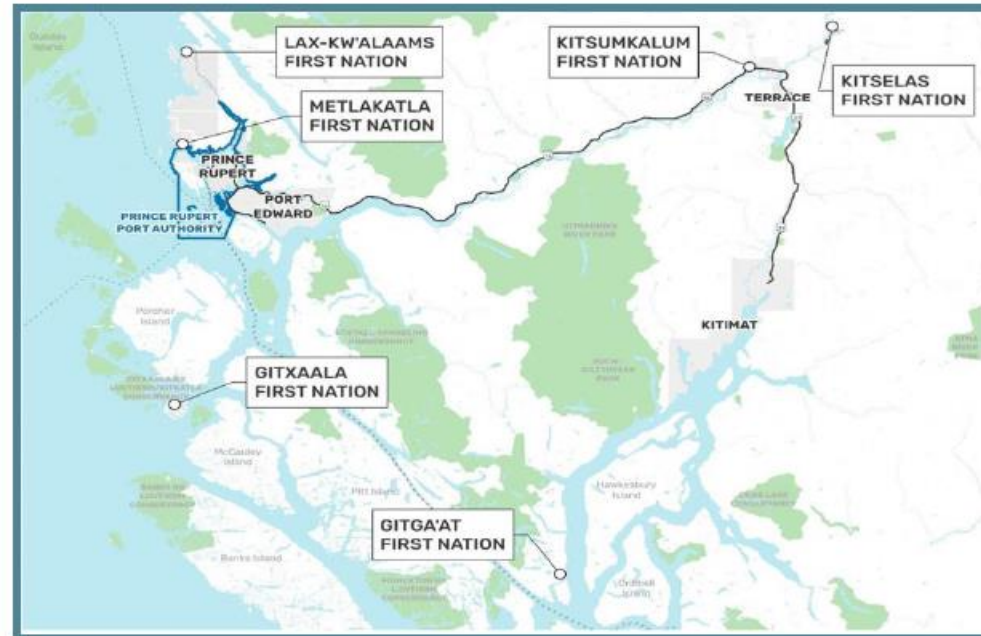

We recognize the opportunity our partnership and use of Coast Tsimshian Territories provides for the success of our employees, families, community and nations.



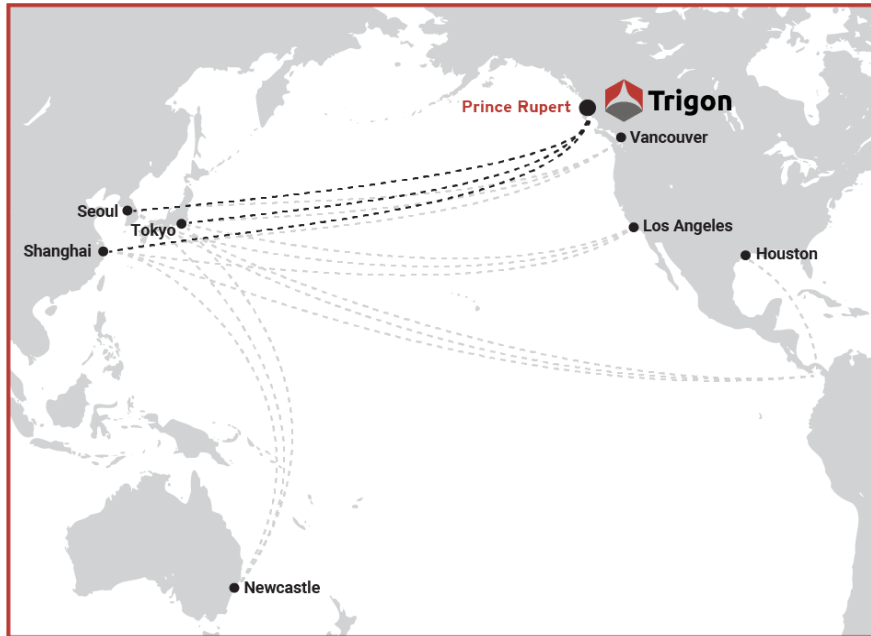

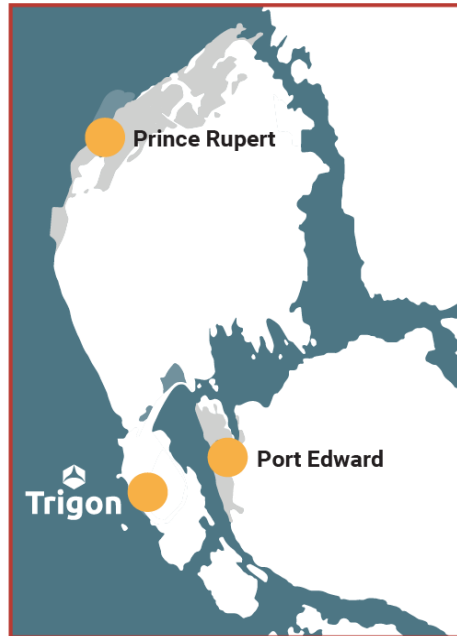


Our Location is Our Advantage
